- 5.1 The Seller is the sole legal owner and has full authority to sell the motorcycle.
- 5.2 The motorcycle is free from finance, hire-purchase, logbook loans, liens, or encumbrances.
- 5.3 The motorcycle has not been reported stolen and is not subject to any court order.
- 5.4 The odometer reading is accurate to the best of the Seller's knowledge.
- 5.5 The motorcycle has not been declared Category A, B, S, or N write-off unless disclosed in Section 4.
- 5.6 No false representations have been made (Misrepresentation Act 1967); the motorcycle is not in a dangerous condition contrary to Road Traffic Act 1988 s.75.
- 5.7 The V5C is evidence of registered keepership only, NOT proof of ownership (RV(R&L) Regs 2002).

6. "AS IS" SALE

Subject to Section 5, the motorcycle is sold as seen, tried and approved. No further warranties are given beyond those implied by the Consumer Rights Act 2015 and Sale of Goods Act 1979.

7. DVLA AND ADMINISTRATIVE OBLIGATIONS

The Seller shall notify the DVLA of the change of ownership using the V5C within 5 working days of sale. The Buyer must tax and insure the motorcycle before riding on a public road. Both parties should retain a signed copy of this document.

8. GOVERNING LAW

This Agreement is governed by the law of England and Wales. Disputes shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of England and Wales.
